



Guidelines for Triathlon Swimmers Lake Juliette



Swimmers must stop by our gatehouse to inform the park hosts that they will be swimming. A list of the swimmer's names using Lake Juliette must be provided to the park hosts to help us keep track of the Triathlon swimmers and to ensure each swimmer has reviewed and is knowledgeable of the guidelines.

Swimmers can swim from the pavilion area only when pavilion has not been reserved. This information will be confirmed at gate house.

- Parking is permitted in pavilion lot
- All personal items and clothing should be kept in vehicles
- Only towels will be permitted inside the pavilion

Only swimmers on list are allowed in the campground area. Family members are to use the day use area while waiting for swimmers.

Swimmers are to use bathrooms in day use area only. Campground restrooms are only available to our campers.

Swimmers are not to use the showers in the campground comfort station. Swimmers are to use the outside shower by the pavilion.

Swimmers (or each vehicle) must purchase an annual park pass. The pass will be marked with a "T" to designate you as a Triathlon swimmer.

We want to ensure that the camping experience is not disrupted for our campers and also ensure that you have a safe and enjoyable swim
